Dear Dr. Gurgel-Pereira,

We wish to thank you for your interest in our Program of research Grants and educational Scholarships addressed to university Professors, post-doctoral researchers and Ph.D. candidates. We are pleased to inform you that your candidature for a **Category E Research Grant** covering **six [6] months of research in Greece in the academic year October 2017 - September 2018**, has been approved by the Board of Directors of the Foundation.

Your grant consists of a round trip **air-ticket** (economy class) up to one thousand euro [**€ 1.000**] from and to the place of your usual residence and a **monthly allowance** of one thousand five hundred euro [**€ 1.500**] for subsistence and all other expenses, as approved by the Board of Directors in July 2017.

We would appreciate it if you could kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter and confirm to us, no later than September 1st, 2017, that you will use the awarded research grant in the period **October 1, 2017 - September 30, 2018**. Please note that the academic year in Greece consists of two semesters; the first semester starts in October and ends in the middle of January (with a fifteen-day break for Christmas), and the second semester starts in the middle of February and ends in May (with a fifteen-day break for Easter).

We wish to inform you that, in order for this grant to be implemented and for the terms and reciprocal benefits of this cooperation to be clarified, **a private agreement will be signed**. The agreement text will be forwarded to you upon acceptance of this fellowship on your behalf; you will be asked to sign and return one copy to the coordinator of the Onassis Foreigners' Fellowships Program.

The Onassis fellowship has been awarded to you on the basis of your collaboration with Prof. P. Kousouris, Univ. of the Aegean, for the organisation of series of seminars addressed to postgraduate students from the above mentioned university. Prof. P. Kousouris is bound to send to the Onassis Foundation, at the end of the fellowship, a final progress report in which the benefits of your scientific collaboration will be described.

It is your obligation to the Foundation to publish one scientific article in a peer-reviewed journal, within twenty-four (24) months from the use of your grant, as a result of your research.

You are also kindly asked to submit to the coordinator of the Programme written academic reports (3-5 pages) every month and at the end of your stay in Greece describing your academic activities and any comments you may have regarding our Programme.
